

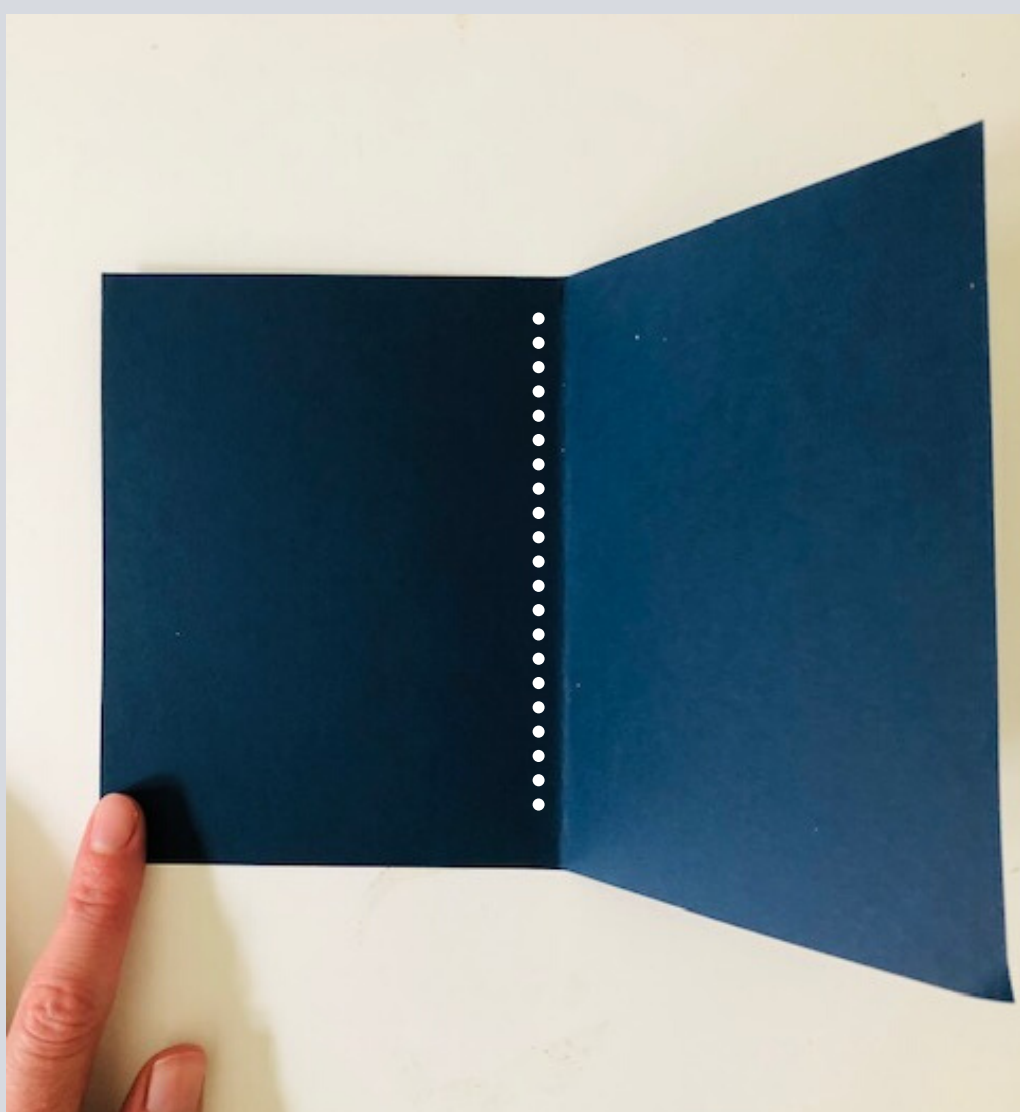
# MUSEUM IN A MINUTE

## THURSDAY ART PLAY: PAPER KITES

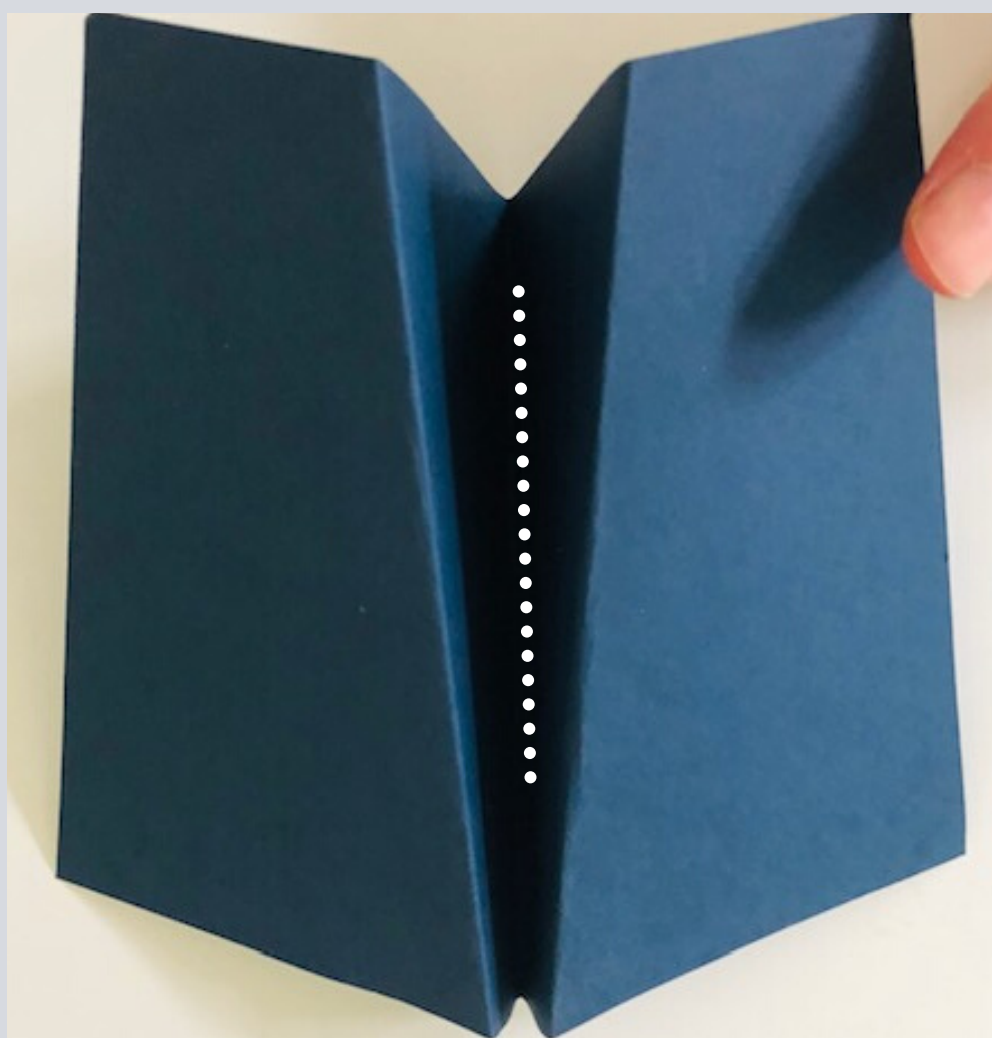
THE ARTIST TOMÁS SARACENO MADE A FLYING KITE-LIKE SCULPTURE CALLED *SOLAR BELL*. LEARN HOW TO MAKE A PAPER KITE, OR... IF YOU'RE FEELING BRAVE, FOLLOW THE [LINK](#) TO MAKE A TETRAHEDRON KITE LIKE SARACENO!



Fold your paper in half. Fold the top layer back at an angle. Leave 1 inch at the top and 2-3 inches at the bottom. Now fold the bottom layer back to match the same angle as the front.



If both sides match your folding is done. Turn it over and tape both sides together at the top and bottom of the kite. On the other side, tape a stick to the front for support.

## THURSDAY ART PLAY: PAPER KITES

Punch a hole on the middle back flap of the kite. Tie your string through the hole. Tape on streamers, ribbon or string for the tail.



Decorate the front of the kite with markers and/or collage materials. Now go fly your kite!
