

# MUSEUM IN A MINUTE

## WOVEN PORTRAITS

THE STREET ARTIST VHILS TAKES DISCARDED ADVERTISING POSTERS, LAYERS THEM ON TOP OF EACH OTHER AND COVERS THEM WITH WHITE PAINT. HE USES THIS AS A CANVAS TO CARVE PORTRAITS INTO THE PAPER.

MATERIALS: RECYCLED MAGAZINES/NEWSPAPERS, SCISSORS, GLUE/TAPE

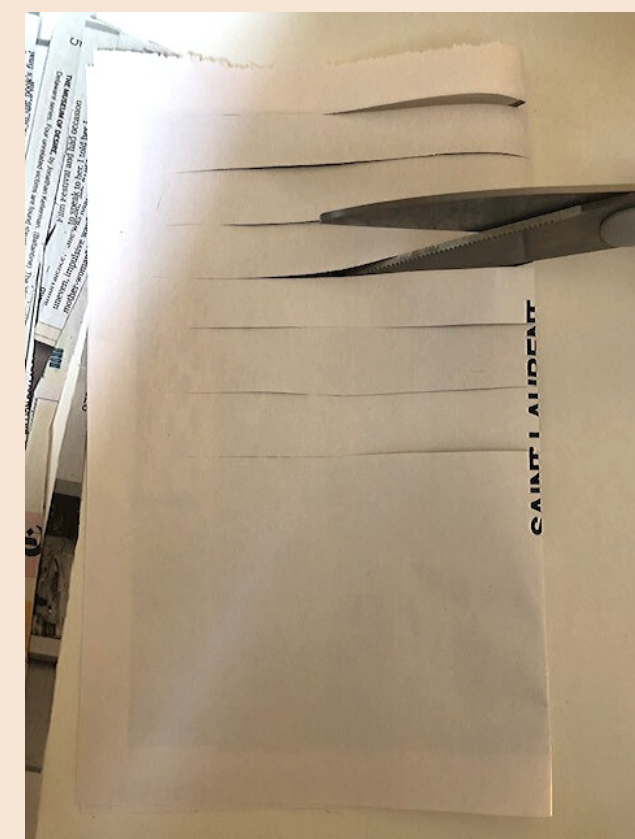
CREATE YOUR OWN LAYERED PORTRAITS USING RECYCLED MATERIALS.



- 1 Look through old magazines + newspapers to find an image you like. Portraits and landscapes tend to work best!



- 2 Fold the image in half + cut lines across the paper (starting with the folded side). Be careful not to cut to the end of the paper.



- 3 Cut the remaining magazines into strips. Weave each strip across the image to create a layered portrait collage.



- 4 Secure the edge of each strip with a glue stick or tape, now your Vhils-inspired woven portrait is complete!
